FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS

Oath of Office for Newly Elected Supervisors Elected at General Election held November 8, 2016 for Seat #1 and Seat #2

Mr. Winkeljohn, being a Notary Public of the State of Florida administered the oath of office to Ms. Price and Ms. Stewart, and briefly went over the information in the new board member packets that were provided to them. The signed oaths will become part of the public record.

SECOND ORDER OF BUSINESS Roll Call

Mr. Winkeljohn called the meeting to order and called the roll.

THIRD ORDER OF BUSINESS

Audience Comments (Related to Right to Speak Statute Changes)

There not being any, the next item followed.

FOURTH ORDER OF BUSINESS Organizational Matters

A. Consideration of Resolution #2017-02 Confirming the General Election Results Mr. Winkeljohn presented Resolution #2017-02 Confirming the General Election Results and asked for a motion to approve it.

On MOTION by Mr. Benjamin seconded by Mr. Price with all in favor Resolution #2017-02 Confirming the General Election Results was approved.

B. Consideration of Resolution #2017-03 Electing Officers

Mr. Winkeljohn presented Resolution #2017-03 Electing Officers, explained that whenever there were any changes to the board the slate of officers could be revised, and asked for the board to name who would be Chair, Vice Chair, and Assistant Secretaries.

On MOTION by Mr. Benjamin seconded by Ms. Price with all in favor Resolution #2017-03 Electing Officers was approved; and the slate of officers were elected as follows: Nathan Price as Chairman, Ray Benjamin as Vice Chairman, Tamara Price, Josianne Stewart, Lindsay Hillstrom, and Paul Winkeljohn as Assistant Secretaries, Rich Hans as Secretary, and Patti Powers as Treasurer.

FIFTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Approval of the Minutes of the May 17, 2016 Meeting

Mr. Winkeljohn presented the minutes from the May 17, 2016 meeting, asked for any comments or changes, and upon hearing none, asked for a motion to approve them.

On MOTION by Mr. Benjamin seconded by Mr. Price with all in favor the Minutes of the May 17, 2016 Meeting were approved.

SIXTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Discussion of Restructure of the District

Mr. Price explained he had been on the board for two years and was always looking out for the best interest of the residents. The district issued bonds while still under developer control and currently owed several million dollars through those bonds,

but the community had not really been given very much value for the amount of money they were paying. Now that the CDD was fully resident controlled, a lot more could be done to benefit the residents and restructuring the district by terminating the current management and attorney staff would be the first steps to move towards that.

Mr. Benjamin indicated he was in favor of supporting what Mr. Price said and wanted to be in a better position to bring the community more value.

Mr. Winkeljohn asked how eliminating the District Manager and District Counsel would give the CDD something different. Finances could be moved around however the board chose; however the CDD still needed a District Manager and District Counsel who were qualified to guide the board to be in compliance and from defaulting their bonds.

Mr. Benjamin responded their HOA attorney was qualified to do both.

Mr. Winkeljohn explained there were ways to cut administrative costs, such as less meetings, let the HOA handle certain contracts and things the CDD currently was responsible for, etc.

Ms. Wilson indicated the management agreement with GMS required 60 days notice before terminating the contract and District Counsel's contract required being provided with notice to terminate it, and advised that the CDD should have another District Manager and District Counsel in place before that timeframe so there would be a smooth transition.

Mr. Price asked for a motion to terminate the contracts with GMS and Hopping Green as per the terms of the contracts.

Ms. Wilson asked if the motion would be to terminate HGS immediately or within 30 days to give time to get another District Counsel in place.

Mr. Price responded they would finish discussing everything regarding the contracts right after the meeting.

Mr. Winkeljohn indicated that could not be done after the meeting without violating the Sunshine Laws.

Mr. Benjamin asked if the board could engage Mr. Weintraub as District Counsel.

Mr. Winkeljohn responded that was possible.

Mr. Price asked Mr. Weintraub if he was comfortable with that.

Mr. Weintraub responded he felt the situation was unusual, there shouldn't be a rush to do everything so quickly, and recommended the board give itself time to work through everything.

Mr. Benjamin asked if 30 days would be enough time.

Mr. Weintraub responded that would be reasonable.

On MOTION by Mr. Benjamin seconded by Mr. Price with all in favor the contract with HGS as District Counsel was terminated with 30 days notice; and Mr. James Weintraub was hired as District Counsel.

On MOTION by Mr. Price seconded by Mr. Benjamin with all in favor the contract with GMS as District Manager was terminated with 60 days notice as per the contract.
